The Herricks School District, in conjunction with Sid Jacobson Jewish Community Center, offers an after-school enrichment and childcare program for children in Grades K–5. The Herricks Council of PTAs has played an integral role in the development of this program and selection of Sid Jacobson Jewish Community Center as the organization to run the program.

As the only full-service Jewish Community Center on Long Island’s North Shore, Sid Jacobson JCC provides a full range of recreational, health, fitness, educational, cultural arts and social services programs. JCC membership is open to people of all ages, faiths and backgrounds.

REGISTRATION & MEDICAL FORMS

YOUR CHILD’S DAY

The After-School Program begins at school dismissal. Children who are in kindergarten and first grade are escorted by one of the staff members. The breakdown of the after-school program is as follows:

- 3:15pm** School dismissal—snack and attendance
- 3:15–4:00pm** Homework Club (you must sign up) twice a week and recreational play
- 4:00–5:00pm** Enrichment class or childcare (each day there are 2–3 enrichment courses offered).
- 5:00pm** Parent pickup for all children not registered for extended childcare.
- 5:00–6:00pm** Extended child care program (including additional homework assistance and recreational play).

PROGRAM CLOSINGS

Whenever school is closed, the After-School Program is closed. If the school district cancels other after-school activities, this program is also closed. The After-School Program may also be closed due to inclement weather. For this reason make sure that all parent and emergency contact numbers are kept up-to-date. HOMEWORK CLUB (Grades: 2–5; 3:15–4:00pm)

The main goal of the Homework Club is to instill good work habits, organizational skills, and a sense of accomplishment in every student. Homework Club takes place on Tuesday and Thursday with the exception of holidays and school breaks. A snack is provided and students who finish their work before the end of the session have an opportunity to read or play organized games. **Fee 1 day \$130 / 2 days \$260**

THE ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (4:00–5:00pm)

The enrichment courses are specialized hour-long classes in subjects such as sports, arts, dance and computers. These classes give the students the opportunity to learn new skills and enhance existing ones. These classes are broken up by age group, if there is sufficient registration.

Students in our childcare program participate in activities such as homework assistance, playing board games, doing arts ‘n’ crafts and going to the playground.

DATES OF THE SPRING SEMESTER

Childcare: January 30–June 21, 2012

Enrichment Programs: February 13–June 15

The After-School Program follows the school calendar. If the school district is closed (either full day or half days), the program is closed as well.

Vacation Programs at the JCC/ Childcare When School is Out

Vacation programs give children the chance to spend their days off from school in style! Every day has a different theme and main activity period. For the rest of the day, the kids participate in sports, swimming (optional) and arts 'n' crafts.

- ◆ Programs run from 10:00am–4:00pm.
- ◆ Programs are professionally staffed, with low 6:1 child-to-staff ratio.
- ◆ Activities are broken down by age group.
- ◆ Children need to bring a kosher lunch (unless lunch option is chosen), bathing suit, bathing cap, towel and change of clothing. Children are not able to swim without a bathing cap.
- ◆ 10% sibling discount for each child after the first.
- ◆ There are two additional options that you may consider for your child:
 - Kosher Lunch Program**—\$6 per day
 - Extended Childcare**—Great for working parents! We have activities starting at 9:00am and ending at 5:00pm (4:00pm on Friday). The fee is \$10 per hour, per child.
