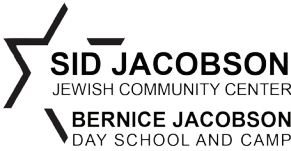

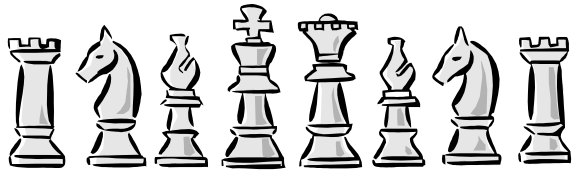

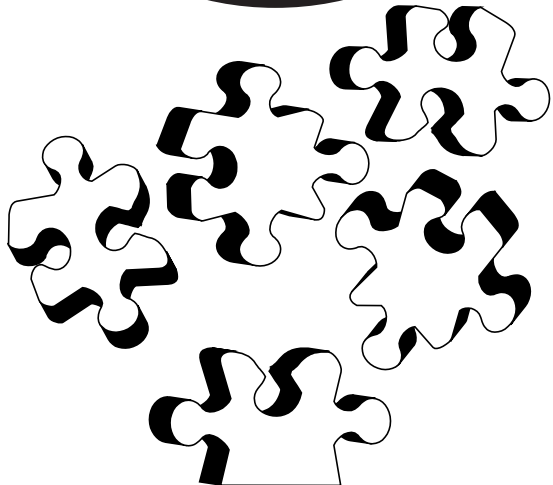

## **ABOUT THE JCC**

Our after-school program is dedicated to giving the safest and most caring school-age childcare in an enriching environment that supports the school's objectives and fosters continued personal growth for each child. Sid Jacobson JCC is a not-for-profit, non-sectarian, social-service organization run by a volunteer board of directors in partnership with a professional staff.

## PROGRAM INFORMATION

- ◆ The program is held at the Guggenheim Elementary School
- ◆ The program is offered in two sessions:
  - Fall/Winter–September through January
  - Winter/Spring–February through June
- ◆ In order to register for the program, the following forms (included in this packet) must be completed, along with payment in full (unless other arrangements are made):
  - Registration Form
  - Transportation Form
  - Medical Form

## YOUR CHILD'S DAY

<b>3:00–3:30pm</b>	Arrival of buses
<b>3:30–4:30pm</b>	Childcare/Enrichment Classes
<b>4:30pm</b>	Pick-up in cafeteria (no busing home at 4:30pm)
<b>4:30–6:00pm*</b>	Optional Extended Childcare in the cafeteria

*\*No busing home available.*

Children are bused from their elementary school to the Guggenheim Elementary School by the Port Washington School District. Daily attendance is taken and a snack is provided. The enrichment courses are specialized hour-long classes in subjects including arts, dance, cooking and woodworking. These classes give the students the opportunity to learn new skills and enhance existing ones.

## CHILDCARE OPTIONS

Each day, children may attend a program that assists with homework and study skills and engages them in a structured playtime using board games and art materials. This program ensures the working and/or active parent a safe and well-staffed atmosphere for their children. Children may attend childcare from 3:00–4:30pm or 3:00–6:00pm.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

Transportation is provided from the child's elementary school to Guggenheim Elementary School after dismissal. Complete the enclosed Transportation Form and return it to the JCC along with the Registration Form. Transportation Forms **must** be received by **Friday, January 13** in order for students to be taken to the program starting **Monday, January 30**. Children who return forms after **Friday, January 13** will start at least one week after the forms are received. Parents can pick up their children at the end of the program, either 4:30pm or 6:00pm.

## **PROGRAM CLOSINGS**

**Whenever school is closed, the after-school program is closed. If the school district cancels other after-school activities, this program will also be closed.** Check with your child's school for winter weather closings. Make sure the JCC has current parent and emergency contact phone numbers in case of program closings. When school is out, the JCC offers full day vacation programs. ### **PROGRAMS FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS**

The JCC offers a social skills program for children with special needs (including ADHD, Asperger's Syndrome and social disabilities). This program concentrates on the development of social and emotional reciprocity, focusing skills and enhancement of self-esteem. Interpersonal relationships and social skills are developed through a variety of creative and education activities in a structured, yet flexible environment. These classes feature activities such as arts 'n' crafts, creative cooking, games, discussion and special events. The class is led by a certified social worker and is held from 3:30–4:30pm on Thursday for grades K–5. The cost of the program is \$400 for the semester.

In addition to our social skills class, children with special needs may also sign up for inclusion enrichment programs. All of the classes offered in the middle of this guide are available. Children who register for the inclusion program must be able to be maintained in a 5:1 child-to-staff ratio.

## REFUND POLICY

Prior to the session beginning—100% minus \$50

Between the 1st–4th class—50%

After the 5th class—No refund

## FEES

Children may sign up for 1–5 days per week. The JCC offers a 10% sibling discount applied to each child after the first. Higher fee prevails. Scholarships are available based on need.

## LATE FEES

Late fees will be assessed if children are picked up after 6:05pm. All fees will be billed to the registrant immediately and must be paid within one week of receiving bill. The fee is \$10 for every 15 minutes following 6:05pm.

## *Vacation Programs at the JCC/ Childcare When School is Out*

Vacation programs give children the chance to spend their days off from school in style! Every day has a different theme and main activity period. The rest of the day, the kids participate in sports, optional swimming and arts 'n' crafts.

- ◆ Programs run from 10:00am–4:00pm.
- ◆ Programs are professionally staffed, with low 6:1 child-to-staff ratio.
- ◆ Activities are broken down by age group.
- ◆ Children need to bring a kosher lunch (unless lunch option is chosen), bathing suit, bathing cap, towel and change of clothing. Children are not able to swim without a bathing cap.
- ◆ 10% sibling discount for each child after the first.
- ◆ There are two additional options that you may consider for your child:

**Kosher Lunch Program**—\$6 per day

**Extended Childcare**—Great for working parents! We have activities starting at 9:00am and ending at 5:00pm (4:00pm on Friday). The fee is \$10 per hour, per child.
