Annual Packing Drive to Equip Long Island Students for Successful School Year

East Hills, N.Y. (Aug. 13, 2025) – With the first day of school just around the corner, Sid Jacobson JCC is partnering with Supplies for Success for its annual "Give Back With a Backpack" event, taking place Monday, August 18, 10:30am-12pm, in East Hills.

Volunteers will pack 650 backpacks with essential school supplies, ensuring underserved children across Long Island can begin the year prepared, confident, and ready to learn.

"When these volunteers pack backpacks for children in need, they're not just providing supplies—they're giving hope, dignity, and opportunity," said **Mindy Richenstein**, Founder and President of Supplies for Success. "By partnering together, we amplify the good we bring into the world, and the light we shine is brighter when it shines together."

This effort is carried out as a day of service through Sid Jacobson JCC's Center for Community Engagement, which empowers community members to give back through its three pillars: Volunteerism, Linda & Gerald Marsden Social Responsibility Pillar, and Nikki Schwartz Memorial Community Needs Bank.

Guided by our mission of *tikkun olam*—repairing the world—we mobilize volunteers of all ages to meet pressing local needs. Through this initiative, SJJCC will outfit children across Long Island with the supplies needed for a successful start to the school year.

Founded in 2002, Supplies for Success has provided more than 300,000 backpacks filled with age-appropriate supplies to disadvantaged students from pre-K through 12th grade before the first day of school, helping to level the educational playing field and promote equity in the classroom.
